Who Are We?

The PEOs will be offering support to schools with their pupils who have a primary presenting need of Emotionally-Based School Absence/Avoidance (EBSA).

'EBSA' is the term used to describe children and young people (CYP) who experience challenges with attending school due to heightened and distressing emotional and physical factors, commonly linked to anxiety. These CYP may also have additional needs, which can further impact their school attendance.



Our Offer

The PEOs will be:

- An early intervention and prevention support team who will offer 2 phases of support:
- Phase 1: Advice Based Support; (EBSA Surgeries)
- Phase 2: Direct Work Support: Coaching key adults through pupil voice (assessment) work.

**For phase 2, Referrals must be made via the Inclusion Forums.*

Criteria

The PEO criteria is that pupils must have:

- A primary presenting need of EBSA and;
- Attendance between 60-80%.
