Equal Education is a social enterprise, offering a range of specialist tutoring programmes that provide extra support for under-resourced and vulnerable students, including Children Looked After (CLA), those with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND), those excluded from school (PEX) and Unaccompanied Asylum Seeking Children (UASC). We are working to narrow the attainment gap and improve outcomes for these learners. Tutors provide stability and a positive role model, they advocate for the young person, tailoring learning to their interests and needs, resulting in increased engagement in education.

To provide education continuity and inclusion, we work closely with the key professionals to identify a suitable outcome for tuition, including; academic qualifications, increased progress/achievement, transition, engagement in school, improved attendance at school etc. We provide quality assured 1:1 tuition with a qualified teacher and can support students through Functional Skills and GCSE exams, as well as facilitating exam arrangements for these qualifications if required. We also have qualified teachers, experienced at teaching A-level subjects, and can provide bespoke support for post-16 qualifications as appropriate. We are constantly expanding the range of vocational and 'soft-skills' courses we are able to offer our students, so please do enquire if there is a particular topic or careers area that would be suitable for your young person. We have a bespoke transition programme for children, including return to school (mainstream or special), a new education setting or post-16 destination, and have robust planning, communication and support plans to enable this. As part of our referral process, we ensure we discuss tuition outcomes and plan transition in advance. Tutors also feed into review meetings and PEPs.
