We specialise in offering personalised packages designed to bridge the gaps for learners, ensuring they receive the training, mentoring, and therapeutic interventions they need to transition successfully into adulthood. Our mission is to address the diverse needs of post-16 learners, particularly those with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND) and Social, Emotional, and Mental Health (SEMH) challenges. We achieve this through three distinct pathways, each tailored to meet the individual requirements of our learners: Pathway 1: SEND Support Focused on learners with a range of special educational needs, this pathway provides specialised training and interventions to support academic and personal growth.
